## Time for Change

Changes! I know a lot of us don't like changes and some of us accept changes as they come.

Well, I have good changes and I have bad changes. Let's start with the bad news.

We recently had a visit from our Territorial Manager, Jimmie Woods.

He did what is called the "Annual Lodge Survey." He found everything to be in order except for one thing.

The Moose guidelines recommend that the cost of goods sold be 30% of what we are selling them for.

Our Liquor and Soda prices are fine, but our beer is not.

With the wholesale cost of beer going up, we will have to increase the price of bottled beer.

You're probably asking why 30%? Well, the other 70% goes to maintaining the building, keeping the lights on, and paying the Bartenders.

So, I apologize now, but you may see an increase in the price of beer soon.

Now, for what some will consider good news.

Our Thursday Night Meal prices will be changing.

The first Thursday is traditionally Hamburgers and Fries.

We are going to alternate between Hamburgers and Fries one month and Open-Face Burgers the next month. The price will be \$6.00 a person.

The second Tuesday will be either Tacos or Baked Potato bar. That will cost \$6.00 a person.

The third Thursday will continue to be Pot-

luck and will remain free to those who bring food to share and \$9.00 for those who don't.

The fourth Thursday will continue to be Fried Chicken (this is the WOTM's Thursday Meal, and all proceeds go to the Women of the Moose.

Due to the increased cost of chicken, the price for this will be \$10.00. That will be for 2 pieces of chicken, mashed potatoes, gravy and salad.

If there is a fifth Thursday in the month, we will serve something different such as meatloaf,

chicken alfredo, etc. and the price will vary (we will try and publish the prices in the calendar.

These will no longer be "all you can eat" (when you go through the line two burgers, a double burger, a plate full of tacos are fine but if you want to come back through the line, it will be an extra charge).

If you have a suggestion on a meal different than what we serve on Thursday nights, let us know... especially if you could fix it and serve it.

The money we make off the Thursday Night Meals goes to pay our insurance and is not used to buy niceties for the lodge.

Our building insurance policy expires in August, and we were notified they will be happy to renew our policy for an increase of \$70.00 a month.

It isn't that bad but is an extra 10 meals we need to serve each Thursday.

I hate to be the bearer of bad news, but someone has to do it.
