Thank You to everyone that helps around the Lodge, we can't do it without volunteers.



WOMEN OF THE MOOSE

Some information from the International Conference in Reno, NV: The Women of the Moose Chapters last year raised \$1,617,908.00 for Moose Charities, \$1,388,000.00 for Mooseheart Schools, and \$1,161,080.00 in community service. Because we fund the Scholarship and Maintenance program, we are the reason that all 14 graduating Mooseheart students have a scholarship for college.

Per Grand Chancellor Barbara McPherson: Chapter members may have diverse personalities, but they need to get along and work together. Find opportunities to have fun and raise money at the same time. Attitudes can cause trouble. Sometimes it is necessary to have a change of attitude.

Unfortunately, 104 Chapters of Women of the Moose closed last year. 8 of those Chapter were over 100 years old. They made it through several wars, the depression, 2 pandemics and yet they chose to cease to be a Chapter after all that.

Please consider being more active as a Women of the Moose. We are still here, still going on, just not strong. There is strength in numbers. It's not that we don't have a nice number of Chapter members of course. It is that the number of those who help or hold office or chairperson positions or just show to the meetings is very low. And those of us that do show and do volunteer, are getting worn out, tired, and quite frankly depressed about the whole situation. Let's not be one of the Chapter's that closes when things get tough. Our Chapter is already over 50 years old. Let's stay around and have a grand party when our Chapter turns 100 years old!

Please consider stepping up and being an officer, chairperson, kitchen help, concession help. We will especially need volunteers for the coming supper. We will have an increased crowd for our Pork Chop Supper on July 21St with the Lodge hosting the Sooner Moose Legion Celebration.
