## Annual Easter Egg Hunt

## Special Dues Offer

This year as an incentive to renew your dues the LOOM is offering 20% off your annual dues if you renew your membership through April of 2020.

What this means is, if your dues expire in April you will need to pay your 2019 dues and your 2020 dues to qualify for the discount. If your dues are currently expired you will also need to bring them current and pay another year to qualify for the discount. If you qualify for the discount you will get 20% of dues for both years. This means it will only cost you \$80 for the two years verses \$100.

Also if you paid your dues between January and March you can receive a discount of 20% on one year's additional dues.

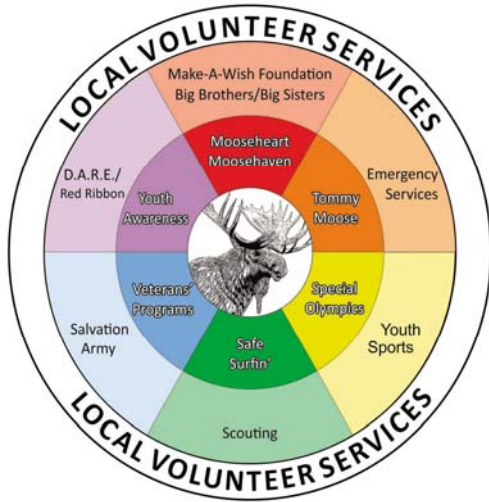
