Smokin' Bar-B-Q Update

Mark your calendars this years' Smokin' Bar-B-Q Competition is September 20th and 21st. In order to open the competition to more people we are changing the format. The new format is designed to make the competition more affordable and competitors will easily be able to compete with a backyard grill.

Friday Night will feature a steak cookoff. The entry fee will be \$30 per entry and will include the meat to be cooked. We will provide each entry with two ribeye steaks, one of which will be turned in for judging. Steaks will be selected by blind draw. The first entrant drawn will choose their two steak and as each entrant is drawn they will select their two steaks until all entrants have drawn. Drawing for steaks will begin at 3 PM with a turn in time of 7 PM. Registration forms and additional information is available at the Lodge. Registration cutoff time will be 6 PM the 20th.

On Saturday instead of the traditional four meat cookoff, we will only be doing a rib cookoff. Entry fee for the rib cookoff will be \$50 dollars and include the meat to be cooked. We will provide each entry with two racks of St Louis style ribs, of the two racks six individual ribs are selected by the entrant to be turned in for judging. Ribs may be picked up anytime after noon on Fri-



day. Registration forms and additional information is available at the Lodge. Registration cutoff time will be 8 PM the 20th.

Contestants may enter one or both competitions. All meats for the competition must be seasoned and cooked on site and not leave the grounds once picked up. We will provide a secure area for you to place a cooler over night if necessary. All contestants must provide their own fire extinguisher, a basic kitchen fire extinguisher is fine. Any cooking method is acceptable, i.e. wood, charcoal, pellet or gas.

We will be selling rib plates both Fri-

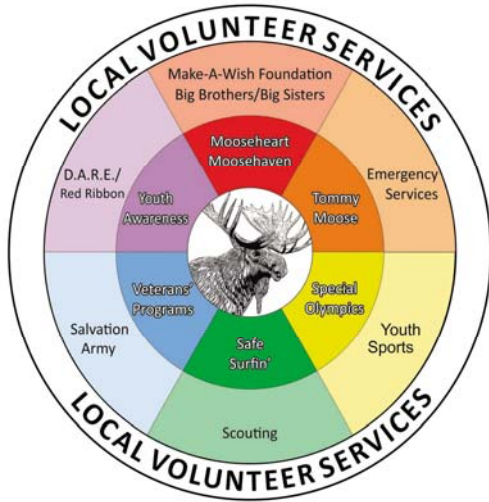
