Please note that the Women of the Moose (WOTM) will hold only one meeting on May 11, 2025.

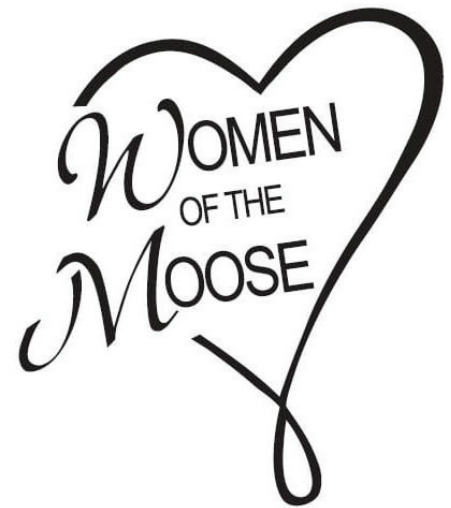
Additionally, the Chapter will continue serving meals on the first and third Mondays throughout May.
